Brief History of Project: The main goal of the OSU Demonstration Garden is to offer the public the opportunity to learn on-site and through classes, the plant material that adapts favorably to our climate, requires moderate water usage and has fire resistant capabilities. The Demonstration Garden includes trees, shrubs, ornamental grasses, native plants, perennials along with annual flowers and the vegetable garden. Included in the Demo Garden are the All-American Selection Display Garden annual beds, featuring new introductions of flowers and vegetables that are being tested for our climate.

The Demonstration Garden teaches sustainable gardening practices which have their foundation in researched based information.
